New York E&O Coverage: The State of New York Department of Insurance does not allow New York Agents to participate in a group policy that contains a group aggregate limit and that coverage in a group program cannot be mandated. This affects New York resident agents and/or non-resident agents whose principal business office is located in New York. New York agents are required to obtain and maintain an E&O Policy with a \$1 million limit of liability. Affected New York agents must provide a copy of the certificate of insurance to WFG Licensing on an annual basis at the time of the policies annual renewal. Please refer to WFG Field Bulletin 3-2006 for further details.

Anti-Money Laundering (AML)

Approximately \$5 to \$20, this is an annual requirement for all licensed insurance agents. It may be included as part of an agent's CE requirement.

License Renewal

This renewal is required every other year to keep your insurance license active. The cost varies by state, but is approximately \$100 plus a \$5 processing fee.

Continuing Education (CE) requirement

Depending on the state and pre-licensing provider, CE requirements cost approximately \$20 to \$50 per year. WFGIA agents can receive exclusive discounts through our continuing education providers.
